Many job applications will ask you about the circumstances of your separation from the army. In addition, being able to confirm an honorable discharge can be beneficial if you apply for an employer that offers preferential hire to veterans. When you leave the army, your discharge is classified in accordance with your behavior and performance during your time on duty. Good or excellent performance results in an honest discharge. The vast majority of veterans receive an honorable discharge. However, if there were problems with your military performance, you can type of discharge, including general discharge under fair conditions, and other than honorable discharge, bad conduct discharge or disgraceful discharge. The type of discharge that you receive determines whether you are eligible for various types of veterans benefits, including the use of the VA Health Services and the G.I. Bill. In the civilian world, your discharge can also affect your job opportunities. Some employers, for example, favor honorably released veterans when deciding to hire. In addition, some employers may also refuse to hire you if they learn that your discharge was anything but honorable. If you don't remember your discharge status, be sure to search before you start looking for work. Knowing that will help you fill out job applications correctly. In addition, you can request a review of your status, which could lead to innovation that could entitle you to military benefits, while increasing your chances of finding a job.
